Upon the completion of his BA in English Language and Literature, and a BEd in English Language Teaching, Marcus Lau devoted three years to teaching English in two local secondary schools in Hong Kong. His classrooms were diverse, ranging from high-achieving students to those with special educational needs. Presently, he is pursuing an MEd in Special Education, with a specific emphasis on inclusive and gifted education.

Beyond his scholarly endeavours, Marcus holds a teaching role at the University of British Columbia. As a seminar instructor, he imparts knowledge on assessment techniques, diversity in learning needs, and classroom management to pre-service teachers. Further contributing to his field, Marcus serves as a behaviour interventionist, supporting children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

His substantial impact on education was recognized in 2020 when Marcus was invited to share his pedagogical insights at the Learning and Teaching Expo. Furthermore, he co-authored a scholarly article on the evolving role of assessment in education, marking his ongoing contribution to educational discourse.
