





Introducing Peer Review Tool to enhance participation and collaboartion

What is Peer Review?

A tool that fosters collaboration, engagement and critical thinking by streamlining formative/summative assessment on flexible criteria and reflection.

How does Peer Review work?

Peer Review emphasizes building effective classroom dynamics and improving the quality of submitted work through effective peer assessment. With Peer Review students provide feedback on their peers' work improving the overall quality of the deliverables.

Why should I use Peer Review?

This tool:

- Integrate seamlessly into Moodle: group and grade book synchronization
- Provide extensive student progress oversight to teacher
- Personalize **feedback features**: anonymity, rubrics and feedback criteria, formative and summative activities

University Of Adelaide

In a hybrid course of 65 students, students gave feedback to 3 of their peers' written assignments anonymously using PR and also reflected on the feedback they received with a 1-10 point scale.

Students had the chance to revise their work before final submission. Their final submission was graded by the instructor.

To enhance the feedback process and enrich collaboration skills, Deakin University instructors used both PR and GME.

Students worked in groups to produce a presentation, which was then peer reviewed using PR.
Afterwards, they evaluated each other's contributions within their own group with GME.

Boston University

In an MBA online course of 400 students, students conducted formative evaluation of each other's submitted Executive Memo using PR after every live lecture to help them practice and prepare for the final assignment.

At the end of the course, they were asked to write a Formal Memo which was marked by the instructor.
