

Scenario Development Competition 2026 (Student)

Terms and Conditions:

(1) General

1. The organiser of this Competition (hereafter referred to as the “Organiser”) is the Centre for Holistic Teaching and Learning (CHTL) of Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU).
2. By entering this Competition, an entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Organiser’s decision in respect of all matters concerning the Competition will be final, and no correspondence relating to the Competition will be entered into.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Competition if circumstances arise outside of its control.
5. All times are in China Standard Time (GMT +8), following the 24-hour clock convention.
6. The Competition and the terms and conditions will be governed by the Laws of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, People’s Republic of China. Any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

(2) Participants and Teams

1. Current students registered and are studying at higher education institutions in Hong Kong, China, and their affiliated institutions in Chinese Mainland are eligible to enter this Competition (Please find the full list under Section **(3) Eligible List of Institutions**). The Organiser reserves the right to request the entrants to provide proof of their eligibility. Staff members of higher education are not eligible to participate in this competition.
2. Eligible entrants are required to register at the competition website on or before the application & submission deadline as specified by the Organiser. The eligible entrants who completed the registration and were confirmed by the Organiser are hereinafter referred to as the “Participants” of this Competition.
3. Participants who wish to withdraw themselves from the Competition must inform the Organiser in writing on or before the application & submission deadline. A participant is officially withdrawn from the Competition only after the withdrawal is acknowledged by the Organiser.
4. During the Competition, all Participants’ entries will be counted as evidence of participation and for educational research purposes. Please refer to Section **(4) Informed Consent Statement** for further details.
5. Upon submission of all entries, participants agree to abide by all competition terms and conditions.
6. Participants must enter their information correctly. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant who omits or misrepresents any information.
7. Participants may enter the Competition either individually or in one single team of no more than 4 students. One individual may be involved in one individual submission and/or one team submission.

8. After the marked application & submission deadline, late entries will not be accepted.
9. One entry is accepted per participant (for individual submissions) or team (for team submissions). For participants who have submitted multiple entries, only the last submission would be accepted, while the rest would not be considered without any further notice.
10. Entry must be the participant's original work, which has never been published publicly.
11. Participants shall bear the legal responsibilities of the copyright of their entries.
12. The Organiser takes a zero-tolerance approach to plagiarism, copyright infringement, content involving illegal, abusive language, or any defamatory statements. If any part of an entry is found to have the above situation, the entry will be disqualified. This right of disqualification can be exercised at any time, including before or after the winners have been announced. Disqualified entries will not be entitled to receive any prize and recognition, and any prize or recognition previously awarded will be rescinded.
13. The Organiser reserves all rights to use or dispose of the entries. The entries submitted will not be returned and will be owned by the Organiser.
14. Participants are responsible for ensuring all the materials transmitted to the Organiser are free of malware.
15. All winners and/or shortlisted entries will/may be uploaded to the Organiser's official website and shared with UGC-funded or partner institutions.
16. The Organiser has the right to publish the full name and facial appearance of participants.
17. The Organiser has the right to request the winners and/or shortlisted entries to provide identification proof for verification. Prizes will only be awarded upon verification of identity. For team submissions, each prize is meant to be shared by the whole team.
18. The Organiser reserves the right to revise the rules of the competition and increase or withhold some prizes without prior notice to the Participants.
19. In case of dispute, the Organiser's interpretation and decision shall be final.
20. All winning scenarios will be showcased after the competition. The winners will be invited for a short interview / to make a video. They will be provided with the interview questions.

3. Participants must agree that the Organiser has the intellectual property rights of the submitted entries, which can be put into production and distributed, displayed, or published on any occasion.
4. Participants must agree that the Organiser reserves the right to copy, use, modify, display, publish and distribute the submitted entries, or distribute them to any media for publicity or education purposes, without remuneration or other notice.
5. After applying, Participants will be deemed to abide by the terms and conditions, release the Organiser unconditionally from any legal liability for publishing their work submitted, and undertake all compensation to the Organiser for any loss caused by breaching the rules.

(5) Use of GenAI Tools

1. The Participants are allowed to use GenAI tools responsibly and ethically in assisting the preparation of the full submission package.
2. The Participants are required to
 - i) explicitly acknowledge any use, or non-use, of GenAI tools in assisting their scenario creation, and
 - ii) describe how and why they used the tools, if any.

(6) Informed Consent Statement

The activities of this Competition are organised by the Centre for Holistic Teaching and Learning (CHTL) of Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU).

During the Competition, your personal data, your responses, and the relevant data collected by the online environment will be used for the administration and logistics of the Competition, and to determine the winners. After this Competition, your responses and the relevant data will be anonymised and solely used for preparing aggregated statistics or carrying out academic research to improve teaching and learning in university contexts. Please be assured that your identity will be kept confidential and aggregated results will not be made available in a form that identifies you. All the data used for the research will be destroyed within 5 years after this Competition.

According to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance of Hong Kong, you have the right to request access to or correction of the personal data provided.
